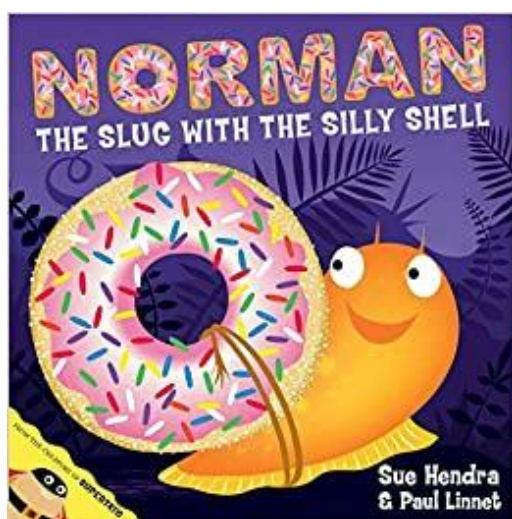
Dear EYFS,
