

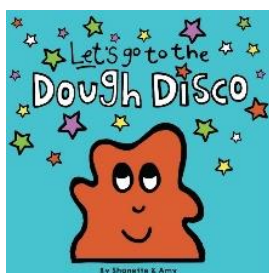
Dear EYFS,

Here are the Random Acts of Wildness that we will be completing this week. Why don't you have a go too!

**Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June** - Snap a blue photo (what blue things can you find outside?)

**Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June** - Identify a wildflower (you could search online to find out what it is.)

**Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June** - Read a wild book (find a book about a wild creature.)

**Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June** - Picnic with the birds (prepare a bird feast with seeds and fruit.)

**Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June** - Create a work of art (use natural objects to create a picture.)

**Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June** - Watch a wild webcam (there are lots of live webcams of wildlife you could try. Try these on the Wildlife Trust's website <https://www.wildlifetrusts.org/webcams>).

**Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June** - Search for mini wildness (Look for lichen, moss or tiny plants growing in between paving stones.)
