Activities to have a go at this week:

#### English

- Test yourself on all phase 2-5 phonemes (work sheet in this week's folder.)
  Go over and practice the ones that you are less sure of. Watch
  Alphablocks and play games on Phonics Play.
- Oxford Owl have added lots of free books, including many of those we use in school to their free library for a temporary period. I have recently emailed you a link and login details for this.
- Watch While we can't hug' <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2PnnFrPaRgy">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2PnnFrPaRgy</a> on you tube and talk about why we are social distancing at school, when out and about and at home. At school we will be trying some of the things Hedgehog and Tortoise do for their friend, e.g. write a letter, paint a picture, make a wave. Maybe those of you at home would like to do the same and send them in via homelearning.
- Practice spelling all Phase 4 words (list and game in this week's folder and activities on Education City.)

#### Maths:

This week in Maths we are revisiting number to 100.

- Practice counting forward to and back from 100.
- Play board games with number to 100.

- Play the exchange game (video on school you tube Channel) with number to 100.
- Try the number to 100 activities on Education City.
- Recap all number bonds to 20 (there are lots of activities in the homework folder on Education City.)
