Activities to have a go at this week:

English

- Recap all of the ways to make the phoneme ee/ie/ea/ey/e. You can watch a clip on you tube at <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2Eunmvlexoc</u> or at <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WO1yIMaWfow</u>to help recap these. There are also some activities on Education City to have a go at.
- There are lots of games to play on Phonics Play and you can also read Phonics Play comics at <u>https://phonicsplaycomics.co.uk/comics.html</u> Have a go at 'A meal out' and 'The Mystery Key.'
- Oxford Owl still has lots of books to choose from on line.
- Watch 'The Ugly Sharking' at <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ooPIboV3YEY</u> Talk about the setting, characters and what happens. Create a story map of the story or a picture of your favourite part – you might like to use crayon and wash like we did in school for our weather pictures.
- Complete the activities on Education City and Active Learn about using s and es for plurals, e.g. 1 dog, 2 dogs, 1 fox, 2 foxes..



Maths

This week in Maths we are revisiting Money and using it to help us practice addition.
