Based on the fabulous experience we had last year, we are certain that that the children will have a really great time. It will be fun-filled, educational and may actually appeal to more of our children than our more traditional Activity Week. Residential trips organised by the school are an invaluable part of the curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that our North Yorkshire visit will prove to be enjoyable and very worthwhile.

The cost of the visit will be £290.00, and this comprises of return coach travel (provided by Roberts Travel), plus full board accommodation and a full programme of activities. I appreciate that this is a considerable sum of money and, therefore, we will offer a savings scheme to help spread the cost over the next few months. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, Income Support or Income Based Job Seekers Allowance you may wish to discuss how we may be able to help with the cost.

To confirm our booking, an initial **non-refundable deposit of £50.00** is required by **Wednesday, 1 June 2022.** which should be paid online via SIMs Pay. Subsequent instalments should also be paid online as follows:
