PE	<p>Children should have a PE kit comprising of black or navy shorts, white t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers in school at all times. No jewellery should be worn for PE lessons. If earrings can not be removed by children themselves they should not be worn on PE days or they can be taped by parents.</p> <p>Outdoor PE kit is required for one lesson each week, comprising of black or navy jogging bottoms, t-shirt and trainers.</p> <p>Our PE Days are: Wednesday & Friday. We may do additional PE during the week, so please make sure your child has their kit in school at all times.</p>
Homework	<p>Please remember that the most important homework is listening to your child read each day for 10 minutes. In addition the children will receive a list of 'real' and 'pseudo' words to practise their blending skills. Spellings and Maths Facts are given out weekly. Homework is given out and collected in and tested on a Thursday.</p> <p><i>Your child can practise homework using their Education City Login.
