

SEND Pupil Questionnaire 2023 Highlights

In June 2023 children on the school SEND register were asked about our school. 100% responded.

Over 70% said they are happy at school ... 30% said just sometimes but no one said never.

78% said they always feels safe when they are at school . This is a 14% increase on 2023.

69% said their work is interesting always or most of the time. This is an increase on last 2022. No one said never.

90.6% said that their class teacher and LSAs always know what they find difficult.

62.5% said that all adults in school always know what they find difficult. This is an increase of 34% and reflects the work we have done on pupil passports and sharing information across school.

37.5% said they always know how well they are doing. This is a 12.5% increase on last year.

Others said they knew most or some of the time.

75% said they had attended an after school club. 100% said they had been offered a club.

88% said that they are treated fairly always or most of the time.

97% said they can ask for help if they need it.

78% said there is always someone they can go to if they have worries. This is an 18% increase on last year. Only 1 child felt there was never anyone available with others saying most of the time.

Our next steps

1. Further develop our school 'behaviour policy' with all staff developing their understanding of trauma informed practice supporting all children to feel happy, safe and treated fairly at school.
2. Consider a range of ways to let children know how well they are doing in lessons.
