## SEND Pupil Questionnaire 2023 Highlights

In June 2023 children on the school SEND register were asked about our

school. 100% responded.

Over 70% said they are happy at school
... 30% said just sometimes but no one said

never.

69% said their work is interesting always or most of the time. This is an increase on last 2022. No one said never.

37.5% said they always know how well they are doing. This is a 12.5% increase on last year.

Others said they knew most or some of the time.

88% said that they are treated fairly always or most of the time.

97% said they can ask for help if they need it.

78% said they always feels safe when they are at school.
This is a 14% increase on 2023.

90.6% said that their class teacher and LSAs always know what they find difficult.

62.5% said that all adults in school always know what they find difficult. This is an increase of 34% and reflects the work we have done on pupil passports and sharing information across school.

75% said they had attended an after school club. 100% said they had been offered a club.

78% said there is always someone they can go to if they have worries. This is an 18% increase on last year. Only 1 child felt there was never anyone available with others saying most of the time.

## Our next steps

- 1. Further develop our school 'behaviour policy' with all staff developing their understanding of trauma informed practice supporting all children to feel happy, safe and treated fairly at school.
- 2. Consider a range of ways to let children know how well they are doing in lessons.
