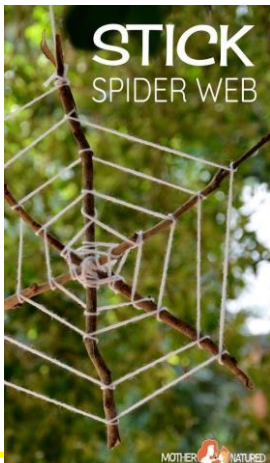
Look through 30 Random Acts of Wildness (see EYFS page or follow the link below). Choose and plan the activities you might be able to do in your garden or on your daily walk.
