This additional area is to take the place of Primary CPD organisation/coordination and delivery and also general Coaching support CPD/extra curricular club coaching for Primaries (sourcing, funding and coordinating), as Primaries now have the funding directly for this.

This slight change in focus of NWLSSP core team is to ensure the greatest outcomes for pupils in PE and school sport utilising all funding to maximum effect

- Increase opportunity for children to achieve swimming requirement
