**Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June** – Decorate with a wild mobile. (Use twigs, string and leaves or paper birds – see the pictures for some inspiration!)

**Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June** – Design a wild home. (You could design anything from a bug hotel to a hedgehog hideout).

**Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June** – Draw a wild landscape. (You could draw a beach, woodland, lake, mountain or somewhere from your own imagination!)

**Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June** – Switch off and tune in! (Can you turn off electronic devices and gadgets all day?)


**Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June** – Race for a rainbow. (Race friends to find the colours of the rainbow).

**Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June** – Map your local wildlife. (Draw a map and mark where you see the wildlife).
