**It would be useful if you could do the following every day (Mon-Fri.)**

1. Practise reading all phase 2-5 phonemes on the phoneme mat.
2. Read your reading book. Share a book with a grown up.
3. Practise reading and spelling 5 of the Year 1 common exception words (5 each day).
4. Try an English activity on Education City.
5. Share traditional stories and fairy tales.

9. Try a Maths activity on Education City using counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.


**In other subjects you could:**

**Science:** Go for a walk around your home. Choose 5 objects and complete 5 sentences about the object, the material that it is made of and why it is made of that material, e.g. the window is made of glass because glass is hard and transparent.

**Geography:** In school we have already found out about England and Wales. You could find out 5 things about Scotland and 5 things about Northern Ireland. There are some information cards on the website.
