English

- Watch 'The Selfish Crocodile' at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o-NhifJ RZI. Talk about the setting, characters and what happens. Discuss what 'selfish' means. Draw a picture of the selfish crocodile and write words around to describe him, e.g., mean, unkind. Write a description of the selfish crocodile.
- Find out about using the prefix 'un.' Complete the 'un' activities on Education City and Active Learn.

Maths

This week in **Maths** we are revisiting number bonds of 11,12,13,1,4,1,5,16,17,18,19,20.

• Watch Numberblocks at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oVLuYTztH-c and explore ways of making 11.


- Use whole part models to find all the ways of making 12,13,14 and 15.
