

# Toilet Roll Fish

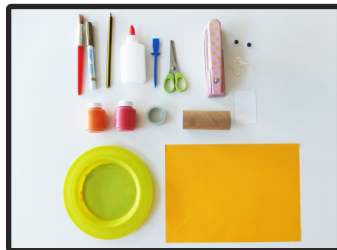
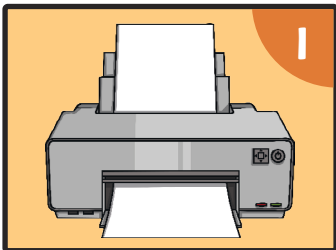
## You will need:

- Toilet paper roll
- Orange poster paint
- Red poster paint
- Stapler
- Sticky tape
- Pencil
- A piece of string (about 20cms)
- A small piece of card (optional)
- Orange paper (optional)
- 2 googly eyes (optional)
- Metallic pen or a felt tip
- Fish Template
- Paintbrush
- White glue (such as PVA)



- Glue spreader or brush
- Scissors

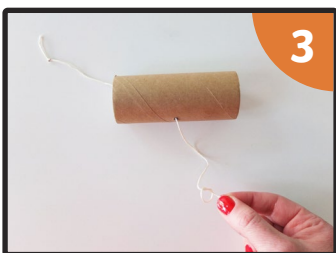
## What To Do:



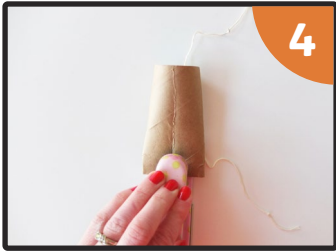
In preparation, print out the Fish Template. Or if you feel confident copying the shapes and drawing your own, you can skip this step.



Lay the toilet roll down and mark the middle of the roll with a pencil. Carefully, push the pencil through the toilet roll to make a hole.



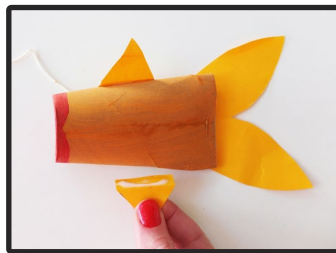
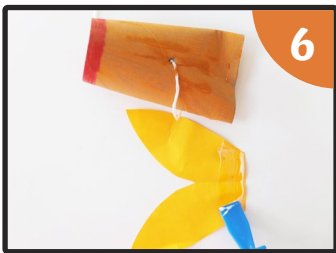
Thread the piece of string through the hole. Knot each end so that it cannot be pulled all the way through the hole.



Squeeze one end of the toilet paper roll together so it is flat. Carefully, staple along the edge to hold it flat. If you don't have a stapler and staples, use strong sticky tape.



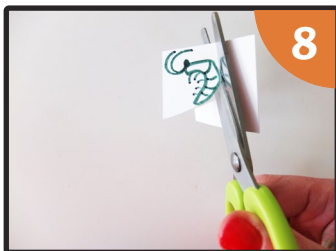
Paint the outside of the toilet paper roll orange. Then paint the inside of the roll red and carefully paint the fish's mouth on to the outside.



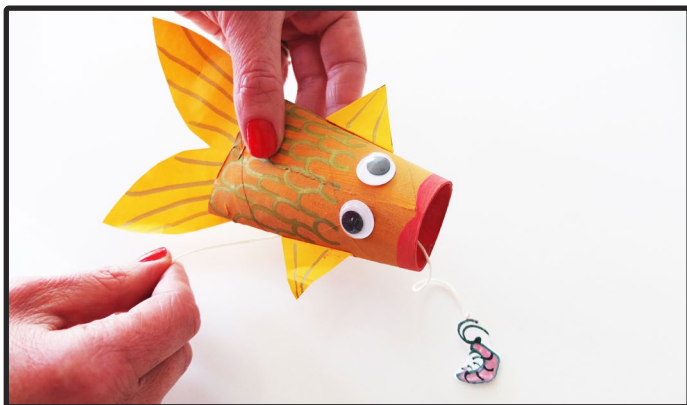
Carefully cut out the fish's fins and eyes from the Fish Template, or draw your own. Stick the fins and googly eyes on to your fish using glue.



When the paint is dry, use the metallic pen (or a felt tip) to draw on scales.



Finally, cut out the shrimp from the Fish Template, or draw your own. Attach it to the end of string in the inside of the tube with sticky tape. When you pull the knot on the outside, your fish will look as if it is eating the shrimp!

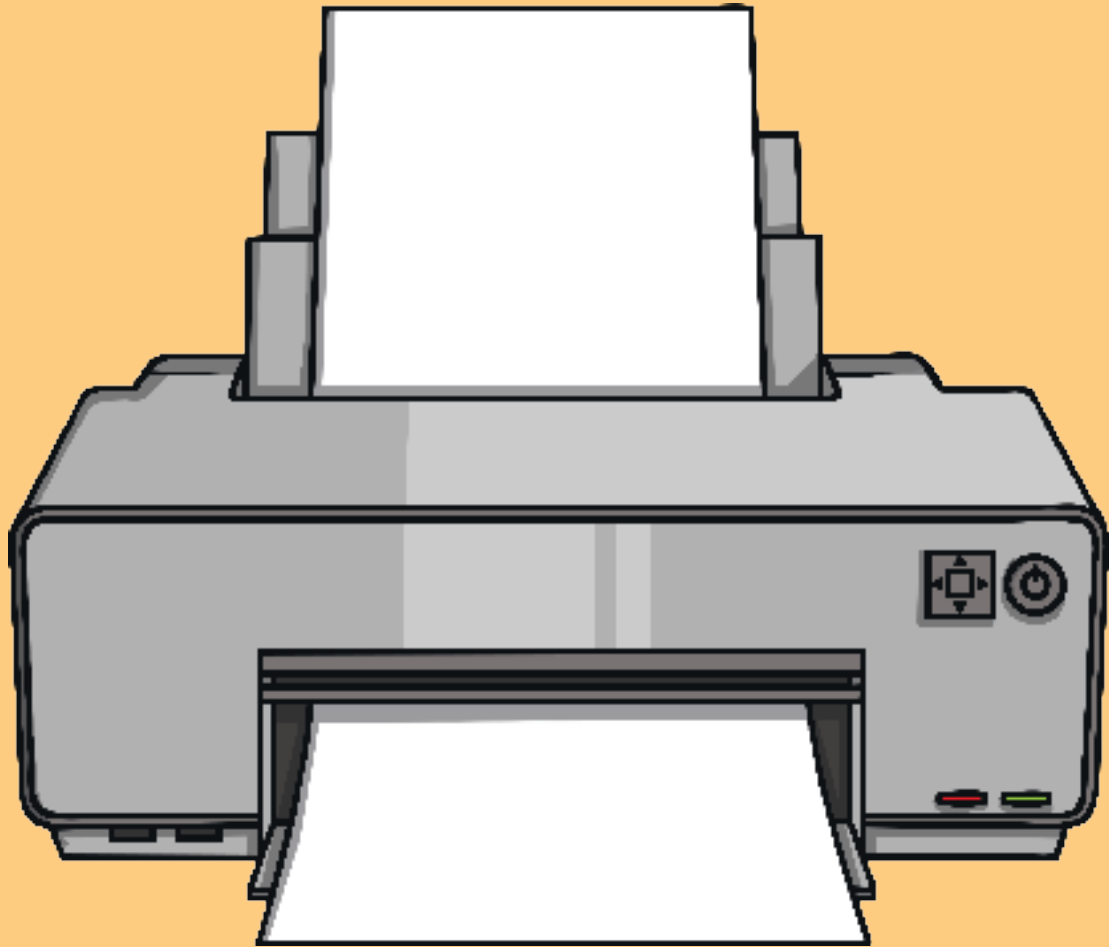


# Toilet Roll Fish

## You will need:

### Step 1

In preparation, print out the Fish Template. Or if you feel confident copying the shapes and drawing your own, you can skip this step.





### Step 2

Lay the toilet roll down and mark the middle of the roll with a pencil. Carefully, push the pencil through the toilet roll to make a hole.



### Step 3

Thread the piece of string through the hole. Knot each end so that it cannot be pulled all the way through the hole.



### Step 4

Squeeze one end of the toilet paper roll together so it is flat. Carefully, staple along the edge to hold it flat. If you don't have a stapler and staples, use strong sticky tape.

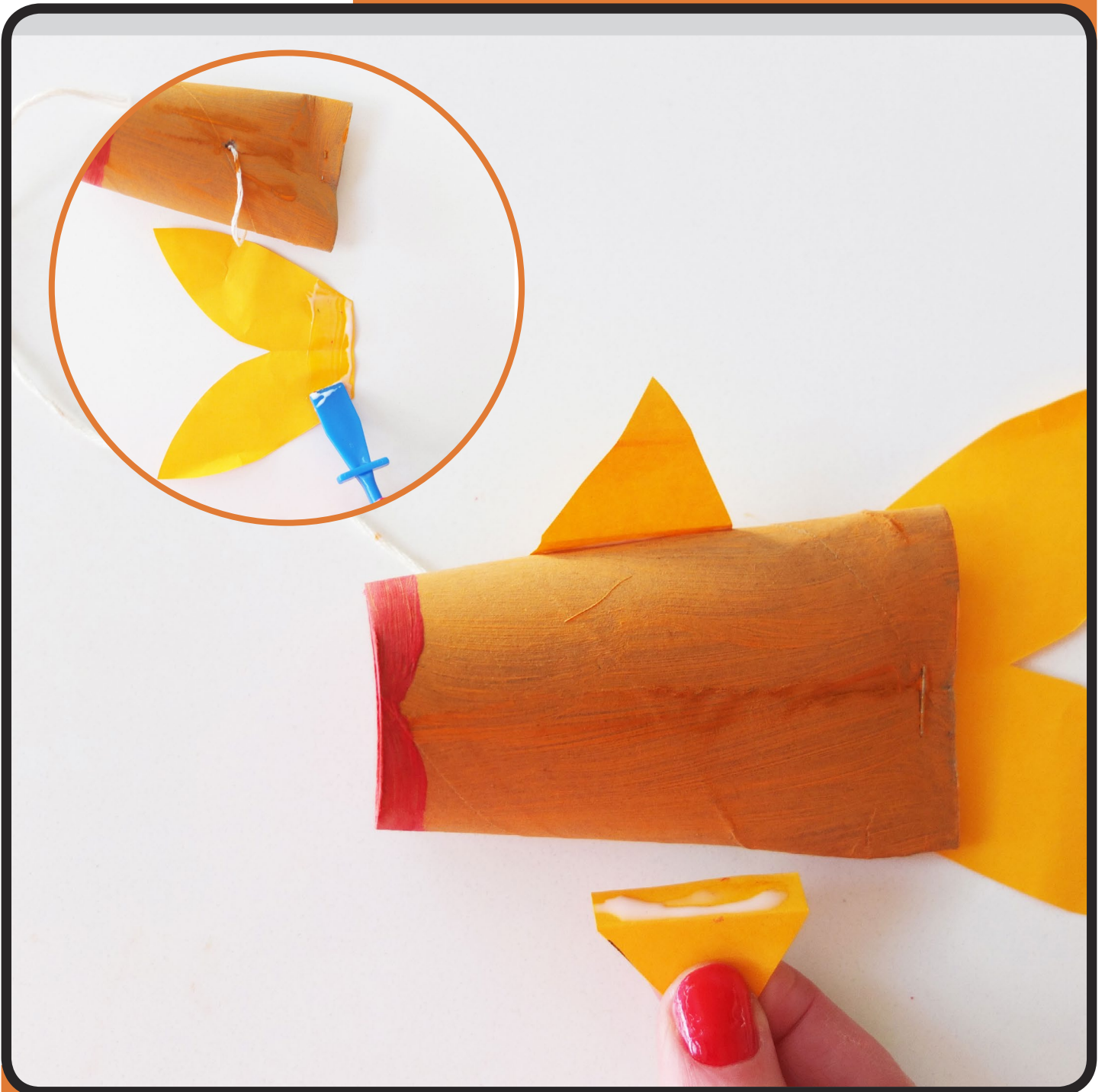




### Step 5

Paint the outside of the toilet paper roll orange. Then paint the inside of the roll red and carefully paint the fish's mouth on to the outside.





### Step 6

Carefully cut out the fish's fins and eyes from the Fish Template, or draw your own. Stick the fins and googly eyes on to your fish using glue.



## Step 7

When the paint is dry, use the metallic pen (or a felt tip) to draw on scales.





### Step 8

Finally, cut out the shrimp from the Fish Template, or draw your own. Attach it to the end of string in the inside of the tube with sticky tape. When you pull the knot on the outside, your fish will look as if it is eating the shrimp!
