Dear Year 4,

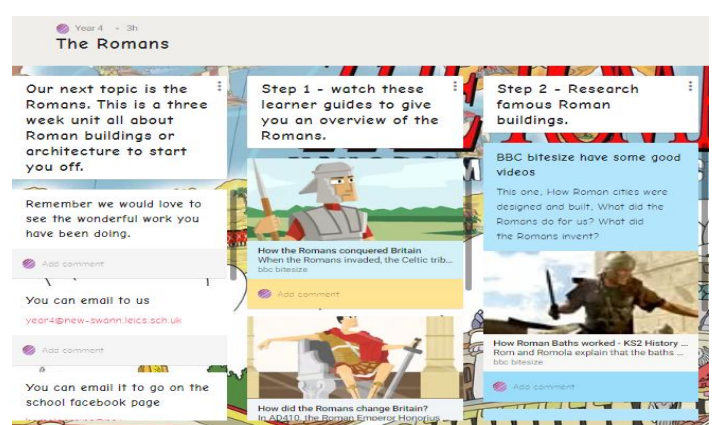
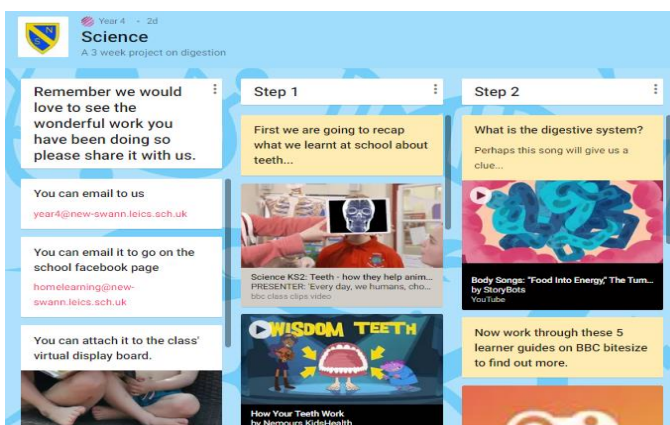
