We have found a website called Read Theory <https://readtheory.org/auth/login>. Your logins are your MyMaths username followed by your initials (in capitals). Your password is your MyMaths password twice followed by @4.

For example,

Login: 123RJJ

Password: CatCat@4

We really wanted to make them identical to the MyMaths passwords but it was one of those sites that want a certain number of letters and special characters! Please email us if you have any problems logging in.
