<u>Literacy</u>

Split your page in three (see website for example) and give section to Romeo and Juliet, Feuding Families and Friar Laurence. Who do you think is most to blame for the deaths at the end of Romeo and Juliet? Write an argument for each one being responsible and then give your own opinion.

Tuesday- Re-read the part of the story from where Romeo finds Juliet dead. Imagine you were a police investigator called to the scene. Write a report of what you saw as you entered the Capulet crypt. Think about where objects/people were and what you think might have happened. I've uploaded a mind map of things you might have found as you went to investigate and the beginning of a report.
