### SPORTS DAY – FRIDAY, 1 JULY 2022

We are pleased to confirm that this year, we will finally be able to return to our normal Sports Days and allow parents/carers to come into school to spectate.

As we will be celebrating the Commonwealth Games in Birmingham over the summer, this year's Sports Day will have a Games 'feel'.

As in previous years, Sports Day will be split into two sessions as follows:

EYFS & KS1                      Friday, 1/7/22 – 9.30am until 11.30pm (approx)

KS2                                Friday, 1/7/22 – 1.00pm until 3.00pm (approx)

Parents/carers will be allowed into our grounds, however, please wait outside until we are ready to allow you all in.

Parking, as always, is very difficult in the lane and congestion will be increased on this day so we would encourage visitors to either walk or 'ride and stride'. The lane is a highway and it is essential that it remains clear and accessible to our neighbours and, in particular, emergency vehicles. Therefore, the area around the school gates (in particular the traffic gates) and further along the lane towards the farmer's access will be coned off. **Please DO NOT park in this area under any circumstances.** This is a significant 'pinch point' and only one car parked in that location can block the entire lane for all road users. We do not want the day to be spoilt by a visit from the local Police (as has happened in previous years) due to the inconsiderate parking of one of our families.

Limited seating will be available and our shaded areas/facilities will be utilised by the children. Please, therefore, be prepared for this especially if the weather is particularly warm/wet. Refreshments will not be available (other than for the children) so I would encourage you to bring your own with you.
