In EYFS, we know that sometimes your child will surprise you or make you proud at home with the things that they know and can do. We really want to know about these special moments as it helps us to build up a rounded picture of their learning and can help us to plan their next steps.

If you catch your child saying or doing something special, e.g., sounding out a word you did not know they could read, helping a sibling, or simply do something for the first time by themselves, e.g., doing up their coat, we want to know about it!

At school we take lots of photos of the children playing and learning. We use these to help inform our assessments and planning. In the summer term you will receive a school report which is a summary of your child's attainment at the end of EYFS against profile measures, known as Early Learning Goals. This report will include lots of photographs of your child showing what they can do in each area of learning.

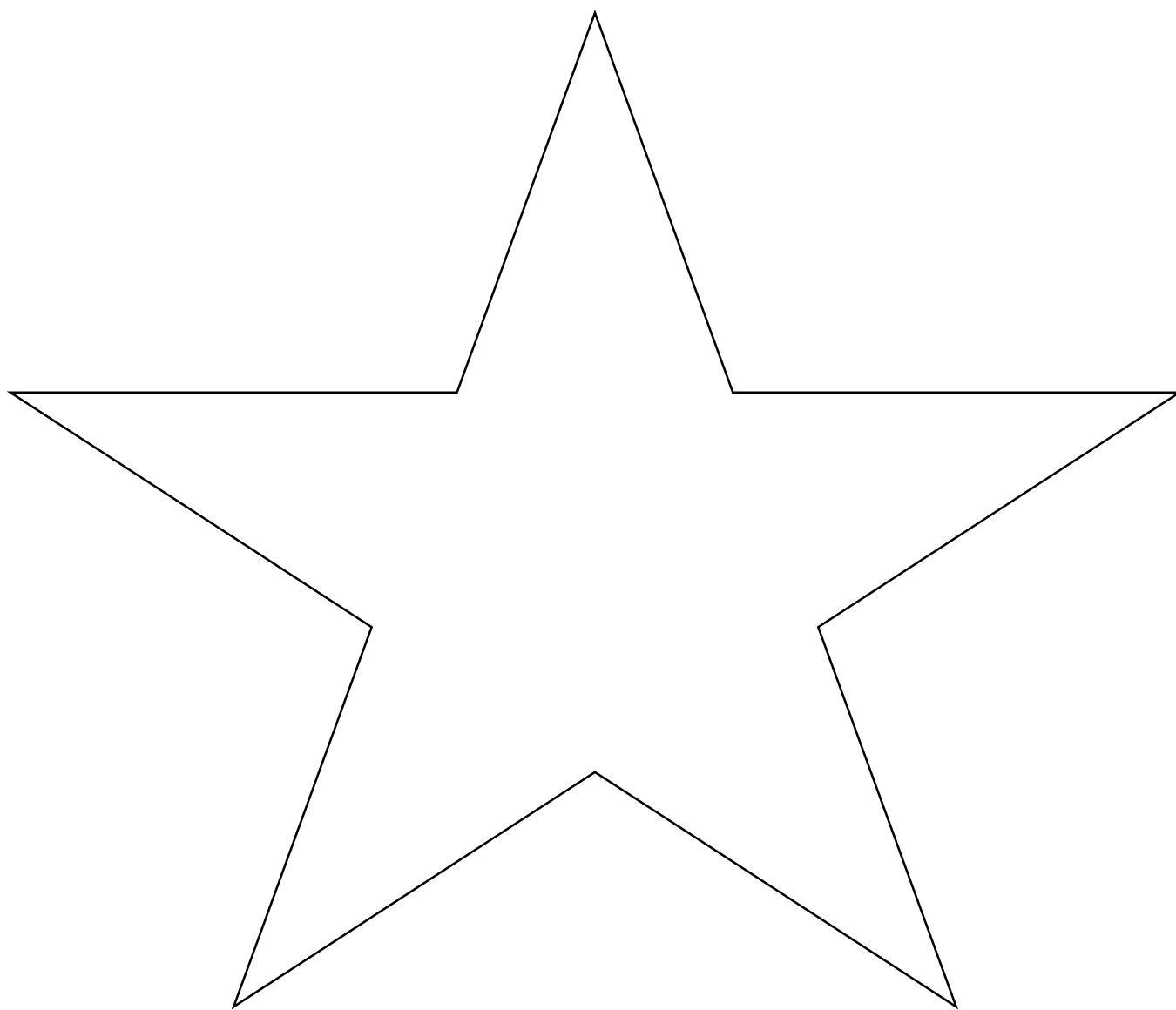

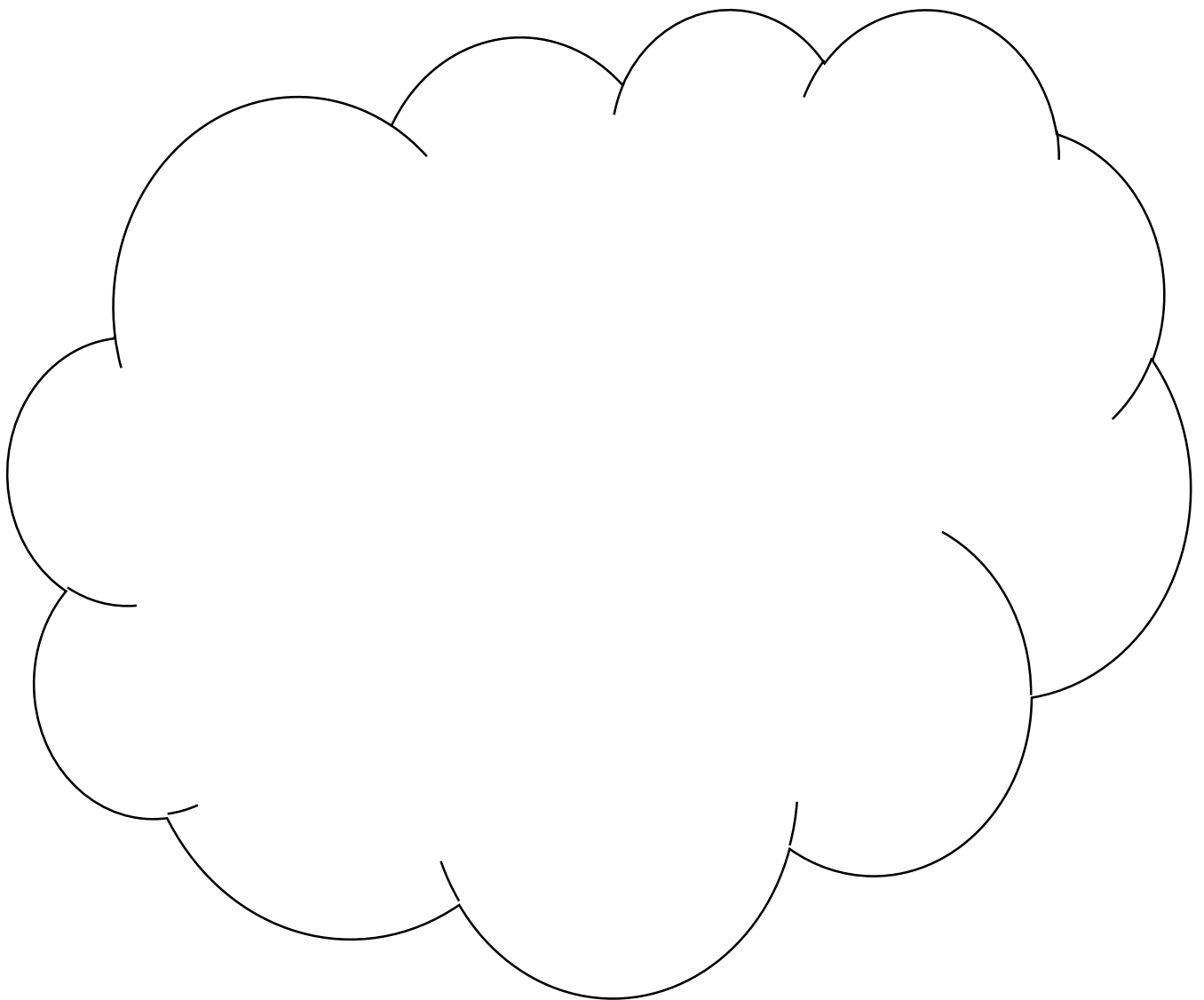
